



BACK TO EDEN GARDEN CHECKLIST

Bed Set-Up

- Cover the ground with thick layers of overlapping paper or cardboard
- Using composted material of your choice, cover the cardboard with 3-5" of compost
- With fresh or slightly composted WHOLE tree mulch, cover compost with 4-5" of mulch.

Planting

- Plant in the mulch, 1-2" down, unless the mulch is very fresh and hasn't composted at all.

If using fresh mulch, scrape plant 4-5" down, in the compost layer.

- For CORN and POTATOES plant 5-6" down.
- Water well after planting.

Watering

- Check garden beds to see if the mulch and/or soil are moist 3" down. If so, no watering it needed.

If NOT, water deeply until soil is moist again 3" down.
- Do not use a sprinkler, especially during hot weather. Use a hose and check under mulch to confirm moisture.
